

## **RIFLE RANGE RULES**

- Always keep the muzzle of gun pointed in a safe direction even when loading and unloading.
- Don't touch the trigger until you have the gun pointed at a safe target and are ready to fire.
- Treat every gun as if it is loaded.
- Use the safety, but never rely on it.
- Never load the gun until you are in a safe place where you can use it.
- Unload the gun immediately after you use it.
- Only use ammunition which exactly matches the markings on your gun.
- Adequate eye and ear protection must be worn when shooting.
- If a gun doesn't fire: keep the muzzle pointed down range with your finger off the trigger; wait thirty seconds in the case of delayed firing; unload the gun carefully.
- Keep the barrel and action clear of obstructions.
- Store guns with the action open.
- Store ammunition and guns separately.
- When unloading always rack the slide and look for an empty chamber.
- Always take care to walk, no running anywhere on this range.
- No alcohol or mood-altering drugs, including medication, when handling firearms.
- Unsafe acts will result temporary range shut down and could end the activities for the day.
